'Boonooroo II' was designed and built in Europe over the course of several years to exceeding standards throughout. Both with respect to her beautiful internal finishes, and importantly her blue water engineering as she is intended to cross the oceans of the world in unsurpassed safety and comfort.

On approaching 'Boonooroo II' you will observe her gleaming paintwork, modern styling and exquisite attention to detail. From the moment you step on board the meticulously laid teak decks feel inviting underfoot. Both the cockpit and expansive



flybridge offer entertaining and or dining zones with exceptional views.

As you step inside the vessel you are drawn to the comfortable saloon seating area which is accentuated by timeless joinery details, thoughtful wall panelling detail and soft furnishings. A dinette is immediately adjacent the well-appointed galley forward of the saloon area. The pilothouse provides excellent vision underway and equipped with recently installed Furuno touch screen electronics including numerous duplicated systems.

Below deck guests have a choice of three well-appointed cabins each with their own toilet and shower. The highlight is the full-beam mid-master cabin.

'Boonooroo II' will sprint to over 20 knots when required, and is stabilized for comfort. Her 12,000 litres of diesel allows for ultra long range cruising and makes her well suited as a private mother ship supporting a sports fishing vessel. She also has provision to carry two tenders for water sports activities.
